- All students in ENSU and SAU 7 attend “Canaan Middle School”.
- Shifting middle school students from Colebrook to Canaan creates enough space in Colebrook Elementary School to house Colebrook HS students, enabling Colebrook Academy to be de-commissioned
- Canaan and Colebrook have small high schools with roughly equal enrollments. If complementary programs can be developed in the schools (*e.g. vocational offerings at Canaan and arts programs at Colebrook*), students would have more alternatives than are currently available.

Advantages:

- Retains K-5 in all communities
- Institutes common middle school program in all ENSU, SAU 7 schools
- Minimal facilities upgrades required
- Significant savings realized due to consolidation, de-commissioning of Colebrook Academy

Disadvantages:

- Overcrowds Canaan School (*highest enrollment in past 10 years at Canaan is 279*)
- Underutilizes Pittsburg, Stewartstown facilities

- Shifting middle school students from Colebrook to Canaan creates enough space in Colebrook Elementary School to house Colebrook HS students
- Both Canaan and Colebrook have small high schools with equal enrollments. If complementary programs can be developed in the schools, students would have a broader selection than is currently available.

Advantages:

- Minimal facilities upgrades required
- Institutes common middle school program in all ENSU, SAU 7 schools
- Achieves maximum savings due to two consolidations, de-commissioning of Colebrook Academy

Disadvantages:

- Assigns K-3 Canaan students to attend Stewartstown
- Overcrowds Canaan (*highest enrollment in past 10 years at Canaan is 279*)
- Underutilizes Pittsburg

Advantages:

- Retains K-5 in all communities
- Optimizes use of Pittsburg, Colebrook Elementary Schools; Canaan facility
- Results in substantial savings due to two consolidations, de-commissioning of Colebrook Academy
- Provides all HS programs in one central location

Disadvantages:

- Requires Canaan K-2 students to attend Stewartstown
- Will require renovations at Canaan (*e.g. locker rooms; media center; art and music rooms; science area*)

Description:

- All students except Colebrook K-3 attend K-5 in their currently assigned school.
- Shifting Pre-K to grade three students from Colebrook to “Colebrook Early Childhood Center” creates enough space in Colebrook Elementary School to house Colebrook HS students and allow for de-commissioning of Colebrook Academy
- All ENSU and SAU 7 secondary students remain in current facilities
- ***If*** complementary programs can be developed in the high schools, students would have a broader selection than is currently available.

Advantages:

- Least disruptive to communities since ENSU and SAU 7 secondary students remain in current facilities
- Transportation, logistics associated with conversion of facilities to new uses minimized

Disadvantages:

- Limited savings due to lack of consolidation, operation of new facility
- Limited opportunities for expansion of middle school, high school programs

Description:

- This plan assumes all students stay in their currently assigned school.
- Ad hoc arrangements could be expanded as a result of this study, providing more opportunities for students
 - Vocational education expansion via tuitions
 - Combined sports teams, drama clubs, bands, etc.
 - AREA agreements

Advantages:

- Least disruptive to communities since ENSU and SAU 7 all students remain in current facilities
- Transportation, logistics associated with conversion of facilities to new uses eliminated
- Local boards can address financial trade-offs at the local district level

Disadvantages:

- Lost opportunity to realize savings, economies of scale through consolidation
- Colebrook Academy deferred maintenance will need to be addressed
- Opportunities for students *potentially* diminished
