

Mr. Nichols's Emergency Medical Technician students have been integrating practical/textbook applications. They recently completed Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation for the Professional Rescuer and have trained on patient assessment and taking vital signs. Most recently they learned how to set up a 12 lead EKG for cardiac monitoring and are holding a clinic on Tuesday afternoon, Nov. 24, in the gymnasium from 12:15-2:30 for staff members who want their vital signs checked. This will provide students a chance to practice their skills as well as staff an opportunity to see their numbers for blood pressure, oxygen saturation, respiration and neurological functioning.
