Good Afternoon Families and Students,

Beginning Monday, March 23, 2020, we will be providing **free** breakfast and lunch daily for every student in the Canaan School District. The buses and delivery drivers will be leaving Canaan Schools at 8:00 am to start delivering to our students in the following towns: Beecher Falls, Bloomfield, Canaan, Lemington, Norton, Stewartstown and West Stewartstown.

Delivery personnel will leave your meals on your doorstep and knock or ring the doorbell to notify you. We will be practicing social distancing due to the recommendations regarding COVID-19. There is no need to greet the delivery person at the door. They are only alerting you as a courtesy.

If you have a cooler available, they will leave your meals in the cooler. We recommend this method if you are unable to be available, as there will be some perishable items such as milk enclosed. If you don't have a cooler, please retrieve the items timely to prevent spoiling.

If you prefer to make alternative arrangements for delivery or have suggestions on where to place the meals, please contact me. We would also like to remind families to keep all pets safely secured during the delivery hours of 8:00am-10:00am. All deliveries will follow the school calendar. There will not be any deliveries on scheduled Administrative Days, Holidays, or Vacation Weeks.

We appreciate your patience as we navigate our ways through this new process. We are very fortunate to have wonderful people to assist us with providing these necessary meals to our students during the closure.
